

PRESERVED ALOE JUICE AS HAEMOSTATIC AGENT FOLLOWING
TONSILLECTOMY

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Aloe juice is obtained by squeezing fresh aloe leaves with the aid of a pressing machine and by preserving the juice in alcohol (20 parts of alcohol to 80 parts of aloe. A cotton wool swab soaked in the juice is applied with pressure to the wound surface. A good haemostatic effect is noted, followed by fairly rapid healing of the tonsillary niches.
